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What are some good general safe work practices?

- **DO** follow safe job procedure for refueling as set out by the manufacture
- **DO** ensure the right mix of oil and gas is used.
- **DO** ensure head is greased.
- **DO** ensure guards are in place at all times.
- **DO** follow Roto Tiller and Edger manufacturer instructions for safe operation.
