## What is a proper safe work procedure to follow?

- Do an inspection of the work area before starting any task
- Make eye contact with all equipment operators to ensure they see you
- Stay alert and periodically look at surroundings to ensure safety
- Request assistance to move all heavy or awkward objects
- Practice good housekeeping
- If you identify a hazard do what you can to fix it and report it to your supervisor for follow up
- Follow all the rules and Personal Protective Equipment requirements on the site
