## What is a proper safe job procedure to follow?

- Do not wear loose or torn clothing
- Ensure all materials are off the belt
- Turn off the conveyor and lock it out
- Clean around the tail pulley, carrier and return rollers using a straight handled shovel (not "D" handle)
- Remove materials from underneath and around the conveyor
- Carry out maintenance/repairs as required
- Replace any guards or shields removed for cleaning and maintenance work
- Never jump or climb onto a conveyor for any reason while it is operating
