## What is a proper safe job procedure to follow?

- Do a thorough inspection of the site
- If possible, enter the building with supervisor to look for:
  - o People
  - Appliances containing Freon
  - o Hazardous substance, such as asbestos and lead paint
  - Tanks, wells, flammable or explosive material
- Ensure that all the proper permits have been obtained
- Ensure all utilities have been disconnected
- Notify property owner and adjoining property owners of time and date of demolition
- Demolitions to buildings adjoined to another building must be properly stabilized
- Barricade or fence the entire area to keep bystanders and traffic out of area
- Proceed with demolition
- Sort and haul away waste and rubble to appropriate facilities
- Clean up site as per local government regulations
- Remove barricades
