What is a proper safe job procedure to follow?

- Assign a spotter who will be in charge of signaling operator and guiding trench box in trench
- Check grounding to ensure it is stable
- Ensure trench box is properly rigged to the machine by a competent rigger
- Begin the lift when all workers are at a safe distance and spotter signals to position over trench
- Slowly and cautiously lift trench box and follow direction of the spotter to position over trench
- Lower trench box as per spotter, be sure to keep trench box level
- Once trench box is in place wait for direction as to when it is clear to back away from the trench
- Back away slowly
