Certificate of Recognition (COR®) is a health & safety certification program for organizations in construction and related industries. COR® is proof a company's safety program meets nationally established standards outlined by the Canadian Federation of Construction Safety Associations. It also meets the Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) Safety Certified criteria. Companies who maintain COR® standard are leaders in their industry, working to reduce workplace incidents and injuries.
